(PMP)[®] Eligibility Requirements

Either

Option 1:

- A minimum 3 years of project management experience with 4,500 hours spent leading/directing projects.
- Bachelor's degree or global equivalent

OR

Option 2

- A minimum 5 years of project management experience, with 7,500 hours leading and directing projects.
- A secondary diploma (high school or the global equivalent)

AND

 A minimum of 35 Professional Development Units (PDUs) or contact hours of project management education. i.e.- The PMP[®] Certificate Course

(PMP)® Academic Path

(PMP)[®] Certificate Course – 42 contact hours (42 PDUs).

Cost: \$4,900.00
