Information technology professionals are in high demand throughout the world. These individuals are responsible for designing, developing, maintaining and enhancing the Information Systems of organizations. Each day new careers are created for IT professionals, so if you enjoy the thrill and exhilaration of working with cutting-edge, dynamic technology, then an IT career would be well suited for you.

IT professionals can enter the field through various avenues, the main ones being:

Technical Support Specialist:

Technical Support Specialists are responsible for ensuring the information system is always operational. These systems are usually complex, ever-changing, networked pieces of hardware and software that operate in environments where downtime can scarcely be tolerated.

If you are a natural multi-tasker and love working with technology in a fast-paced, highly demanding environment with a knack for problem-solving this is the ideal occupation for you. It demands constant training, and an ability to work well with others, espcially non-technical end users.

Analysts / Developers:

Analysts and Developers are responsible for constructing software that is aligned to the operational, tactical and strategic objectives of the company. The modern corporate environment is highly dynamic. The software underlying key business processes must always anticipate the changing environment in order to maintain competitive advantage.

Constructing quality software requires an affinity for abstract, logical thinking, creativity, imagination and an ability to see the big picture. 
- Students can gain access to the University of London BSc (Hons) in Information Systems and Management programme via the access route. The access route programme can be completed in approximately 1 year.

- Students can begin with the University of London BSc (Hons) in Information Systems and Management programme which can be completed in approximately 3 years.
