

The **BSc (Hons) Occupational Safety, Health and Environment (BSc (Hons) OSHE)** Programme is offered by **SBCS Ltd.**, in collaboration with the **University of Greenwich (UK)**, recognized by the Accreditation Council of Trinidad and Tobago (**ACTT**) and accredited by the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (**IOSH**).

This qualification can be earned in just two (2) years.

The **registration deadline** for the upcoming intake is September 1st 2018.

Direct Entry Requirements

To be eligible for entry into this programme you must possess one of the following:-

- ◆ Associate’s Degree in Occupational Safety and Health
- ◆ NEBOSH Diploma in Occupational Safety and Health (Level 6)
- ◆ Associate’s Degree/Advanced Diploma in a science of engineering subject & NEBOSH Level 3 Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health

Persons who **do not meet** the direct entry requirements but possess an Associate’s Degree in a non-HSE field, may be required to complete the “**Fundamentals to Health Safety and Environment**” Bridging Programme, offered by SBCS Ltd., in the absence of the NEBOSH certificate, in order to progress to the BSc (Hons) OSHE:-

NOTE: Qualifications will be reviewed on an individual basis in order to confirm eligibility. Students may be required to complete one or both of the following bridging programmes before progressing to the BSc (Hons) OSHE:

- Fundamentals to Health Safety and Environment
- Matriculation to BSc OSHE programmes.

Aims and Objectives

The programme aims to produce an individual with competence across the core disciplines of environment, safety and health practice.

On successful completion of the programme, a student would:-

- ◆ Acquire an in-depth understanding and competence in environment, safety and health practice.
- ◆ Have a detailed knowledge of the relevant legislative base with respect to environment, safety and health.
- ◆ Be aware of the role and function of other environment, safety and health professionals and the value of the team approach to environment, safety and health practice.
- ◆ Develop a full appreciation of the physiological and toxicological effects of exposure to, or contact with, various physical and chemical agents within the occupational environment and be able to identify the means of controlling the hazards presented.

The BSc (Hons) Occupational Safety, Health and Environment Programme is accredited by the **Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH)**, Europe's leading body for health and safety professionals, which represents 27,000 members in over 50 countries.
