

The **MSc Safety, Health and Environment/Occupational Hygiene (MSc SHE/OH)** programme is offered by **SBCS Ltd.**, in collaboration with the **University of Greenwich (UK)**, recognized by the Accreditation Council of Trinidad and Tobago (**ACTT**) and accredited by the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (**IOSH**).

This qualification can be earned in just two (2) years.

The **registration deadline** for the upcoming intake is September 1st 2018.

Entry Requirements

To be eligible for entry into this programme you must possess one of the following:-

- ◆ BSc (Hons) Occupational Safety, Health and Environment
- ◆ NEBOSH Diploma (Level 6) in Occupational Safety and Health together with two (2) years relevant work experience
- ◆ An Honors Degree in a Science or Engineering subject together with a NEBOSH Level 3 certificate in Occupational Safety and Health/ or any equivalent health and safety qualification.

Students possessing an Honors degree in a Science or Engineering field, who **do not** possess a NEBOSH Level 3 Certificate in Occupational Safety, Health and Environment, or equivalent, may be required to complete the “Fundamentals to Health Safety and Environment” bridging programme (offered by SBCS Ltd.), before progressing to the MSc SHE/OH programme.

Professional Recognition for the MSc Safety, Health and Environment /Occupational Hygiene

The MSc SHE/OH pathways have been accredited by the IOSH (<http://www.iosh.co.uk/>) and graduates will be considered for Graduate Membership.

Mode of Study

This programme is offered part-time and comprises four (4) semesters. Courses are **semester specific**, meaning, they are offered **once** per academic year.
