Direct Entry Requirements

To be eligible for entry into this programme you must possess one of the following:-

- ♦ Associate's Degree in Occupational Safety and Health
- ♦ NEBOSH Diploma in Occupational Safety and Health (Level 6)
- ◆ Associate's Degree/Advanced Diploma in a science of engineering subject & NEBOSH Level 3 Certificate in Occupational Safety and Health

Persons who **do not meet** the direct entry requirements but possess an Associate's Degree in a non-HSE field, may be required to complete the "<u>Fundamentals to Health Safety and Environment</u>" Bridging Programme, offered by SBCS Ltd., in the absence of the NEBOSH certificate, in order to progress to the BSc (Hons) OSHE:-

NOTE: Qualifications will be reviewed on an individual basis in order to confirm eligibility. Students may be required to complete one or both of the following bridging programmes before progressing to the BSc (Hons) OSHE:

- Fundamentals to Health Safety and Environment
- Matriculation to BSc OSHE programmes.
