Abstract

This course provides participants with the knowledge to navigate Illustrator, Photoshop and InDesign and teaches how to use key features and capabilities of the software to create and edit professional-looking designs for a variety of purposes and situations.

This course will provide learners with the ability to design and layout their own Graphic Communications in a very practical manner. It provides a solid foundation that will allow users to build on for further study into these software.

Target Audience

This program is geared towards persons interested in expressing the ideas they have in their mind using graphics, software, students who have finished A' Levels and may be interested in pursuing a career in Graphic Design, Graphic Artists and Marketing Personnel

Learning outcomes

5. Integrate applications and automate features to maximize efficiency

Course Content

1. Appreciate basic concepts and features of Adobe Photoshop, Illustrator and InDesign

- *Overview:* Setting up Workspaces: Setting up preferences: Synchronize color settings
- *Working with Bridge:* Using the Mini-Bridge in InDesign and Photoshop; Using Camera Raw for TIFF, JPEG & RAW images; Exporting from Bridge; Adding Watermarks to multiple images; Using Batch Rename features

2. Use Photoshop to edit photographs, do digital painting, video editing and labeling for 3D objects

- *Adobe Photoshop features:* Content Aware Fill; Using Puppet Warp; Using new Masking features; Simulating HDR Photography; Using Bristle & Mixer Brushes; Using new 3D Features; Video Editing in Photoshop; Creating Smart Objects; Create 3D objects by using the Vanishing Point features

3. Use the Shape Builder, Pathfinder and other tools in Adobe Illustrator to create graphics for promotional items

- *Adobe Illustrator features:* Drawing with Illustrator's basic drawing tools; Creating Variable Width, Dashed and Arrow-Head strokes; Using the Shape Builder Tool; Using Illustrator's Draw Behind and Draw Inside features; Creating Bristle Brushes; Using Multiple Art boards
- Using Illustrator's Perspective Drawing Features; Creating crisp artwork for both web and print graphics

4. Use InDesign to create layout incorporate work created in Illustrator and Photoshop

- *Adobe InDesign features:* Entering text into frames and pages; Formatting text with paragraph & character styles; Setting up columns; Placing objects from other programs into InDesign pages; Using the Gap, Grid field tools and Live Corner Effects; Creating Interactive Slide Shows; Creating Animations for the Web; Exporting to Flash, SWF and Interactive PDF with videos

5. Integrate applications and automate features to maximize efficiency

- *Integrating Applications for Maximum Efficiency:* Using Metadata with InDesign and Bridge; Linking Photoshop & Illustrator files in InDesign.
- *Automating Features for Maximum Efficiency:* Using Actions in Photoshop; Using Photoshop's Image Processor; Creating a PDF gallery from multiple images in Bridge; Creating a web gallery from multiple images in Bridge
