The **MSc Safety, Health and Environment/Occupational Hygiene (MSc SHE/OH) programme** offered by SBCS Global Learning Institute., in collaboration with the University of Greenwich (UK) is recognized by the Accreditation Council of Trinidad and Tobago (ACTT) and accredited by the Institution of Occupational Safety and Health (IOSH). This qualification can be earned in just two (2) years.

Entry Requirements

To be eligible for entry into this programme you must possess one of the following:-

- BSc (Hons) Occupational Safety, Health and Environment
- NEBOSH Diploma (Level 6) in Occupational Safety and Health together with two (2) years relevant work experience
- An Honors Degree in a Science or Engineering subject together with a NEBOSH Level 3 certificate in Occupational Safety and Health/ or any equivalent health and safety qualification.

Students possessing an Honors degree in a Science or Engineering field, who do not possess a NEBOSH Level 3 Certificate in Occupational Safety, Health and Environment, or equivalent, may be required to complete the "**Fundamentals to Health Safety and Environment**" bridging programme (offered by SBCS GLI Ltd.), before progressing to the MSc SHE/OH programme.

Professional Recognition for the MSc Safety, Health and Environment /Occupational Hygiene

The MSc SHE/OH pathways have been accredited by the IOSH (<http://www.iosh.co.uk/>) and graduates of the programme can be considered for Graduate Membership with IOSH.

Mode of Study

This programme is offered part-time/online and comprises four (4) semesters. Courses are semester specific, meaning, they are offered once per academic year.

- Students exceeding the two-year duration of the programme must pay an administrative fee of TT\$1,500.00 (non-refundable) for each year or part thereof beyond the programme's two-year duration. This fee does not include tuition.

Refunds and Payment Plans Policy

(A) Requests for refunds on certificate, diploma, degree and professional Programmes must be made within one (1) month of the start of classes. In each instance, no refunds will be granted thereafter.

(B) Refunds on certificate, diploma, degree and professional Programmes are subject to an administrative charge of 25% of the tuition cost/module(s)/course fee OR \$500 per module/course, whichever is greater. Registration fees and course materials purchased are non-refundable.

(C) Students in receipt of exemptions after registering for a course qualify for a refund subject to conditions (A) and (B).

(D) When accessing a payment plan a 15% Penalty Fee will be applicable to instalments not paid on the agreed due date unless prior approval to defer is received from the Finance Department.

(E) It is understood that should you fail to meet your payment obligations, SBCS reserves the right to deny you access to face to face or on-line classes; to restrict your access to on-line resources and to withhold certificates and awards until payment is made in full.
