

## **Progression**

Upon successful completion of **Computing and Information Systems (CIS) Level 5 Diploma**, graduates of the ABMA CIS programme gain direct access to the final year of the **University of Greenwich's BSc** in **Computing** (1 year in duration) offered at SBCS, Champs Fleurs and San Fernando campuses.

## **Duration**

The ABMA qualifications in CIS Level 5 Diploma consists of five (5) units. The duration of the programme is one (1) year.

## Semester Start Date

Classes for the semester are scheduled to commence in **September** and **February** of each year. Registration deadline is *last Monday in September* for the September Semester and *last Monday in January* for the February Semester.





The units are semester-specific.

## Entry Requirements

To be eligible for entry to the programme you must have at least one of the following: -

- □ ABMA Level 4 Diploma in Computing and Information Systems or equivalent
- □ Relevant work experience: Learners who wish to enter at this level can use their professional work experience as evidence, provided that this experience is a minimum of two years and situated within a job sector that is related to the Computing field. The learner will be expected to have met all the learning outcomes outlined in the ABMA Level 4 Diploma units. Examples of evidence that will be accepted include:
  - Employer references detailing the learner's duties and responsibilities
  - Certificates of training/courses.

Learners are encouraged to submit details of all types of training that they have obtained.

The ABMA CIS Level 5 Diploma will be offered at the following SBCS campus locations:

• Champs Fleurs - Blended (Part Time / Online)

## **Assessments**

**Final Exams will be held in March and June of each year.** ABMA always strives to release results as early as possible usually within 10-12 weeks.

To register for this programme, you must provide evidence of your entry qualifications by presenting:

- Original certificates along with copies of each
- A detailed Resume and/or Job Letter (where applicable)

If your entry qualifications are satisfactory, you are then required to complete the <u>SBCS Registration Form</u>.

If you require an acceptance letter or invoice from SBCS, kindly note that such requests usually take three (3) working days to process.
