

FACT SHEET

The **SBCS Certificate in Advanced Electrical Installation** is designed for persons aspiring to become an electrician or wireman. This qualification forms the basis of knowledge for all modern domestic and commercial electrical installation work and is therefore an excellent starting point for anyone seeking a career as an electrician.

This course will provide you with a range of electrical installation skills by combining both practical and theoretical training. Some of the topics covered include installing electrical systems to national standards, single phase and three phase circuits, inspection and testing of domestic installations and diagnosing and repairing faults. Assessment is undertaken through a combination of practical assignments and written examinations.

Graduates of this programme will be eligible to apply for the Wireman Licence from the Electrical Inspectorate which certifies electricians in Trinidad and Tobago.

Duration

This qualification can be completed in **one (1) year.** There are two (2) intakes per year in May and September.

Pre-requisites

There are no pre-requisites for this programme. However, basic knowledge in Mathematics will be an asset.

Mode of Study

Classes for this programme will be on evenings (5:30pm – 8:30pm) and will be offered at **Champs Fleurs Campus**.

Assessments

This qualification will be assessed by a combination of written examinations and practical assignments.

To achieve the SBCS Certificate in Advanced Electrical Installation, learners must complete the following:

- Electrical Fundamentals
- Electrical Installation (Principles and Practice)
