The **BSc (Hons) Computing - Network Systems or Information Systems** degree is recognized by the Accreditation Council of Trinidad and Tobago (ACTT) and is the next step after completing any one of the qualifications listed in the “Entry Requirements” below.

DURATION & SCHEDULE

This qualification can be earned in **three (3) years**.

Students will pursue **twenty (20) courses and one (1) project** in any one of the pathways.

Please note the availability of any one of the specialism is based on student enrolment. The Information Systems pathway is the one that is usually run.

DIRECT ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Any one of the following qualifications listed below in good standing can be considered for direct entry on to the programme.

- ◆ CXC (4 O'levels including Maths & English(A)) graduates WITH ABE BIS/BM Certificate or ABE BM/MIS Diploma,
- ◆ Cape/A-level graduates,
- ◆ SBCS Diploma in Computing
- ◆ Matriculation to the Higher National Diploma (HND) in Computing
- ◆ 21 years and over with relevant working experience with IT certifications.

Mode of Study

The BSc in Computing will be offered as a **Full Time** and **Part time** programme at the **Champs Fleurs** campus:

Withdrawal and Interruption Policy

Students that wish to **withdraw (exit) from their programme of study must do so within one (1) month of the start of classes.** Refunds will be subject to the terms and conditions outlined in the Refund and Payment Plan Policy. Also note that if an interruption is done in one semester and a student withdraws in the next semester, no refund is applicable.

Students that wish to **interrupt studies until another semester must do so within one (1) month of the start of classes.** Refunds will be subject to the terms and conditions outlined in the Refund and Payment Plan Policy.

Refunds and Payment Plans Policy

(A) Requests for refunds on certificate, diploma, degree and professional Programmes must be made within one (1) month of the start of classes. In each instance, no refunds will be granted thereafter.

(B) Refunds on certificate, diploma, degree and professional Programmes are subject to an administrative charge of 25% of the tuition cost/module(s)/course fee OR \$500 per module/course, whichever is greater. Registration, administrative fees and course materials purchased are non-refundable.

(C) Students in receipt of exemptions after registering for a course qualify for a refund subject to conditions (A) and (B).

(D) When accessing a payment plan a 15% Penalty Fee will be applicable to instalments not paid on the agreed due date unless prior approval to defer is received from the Finance Department.

(E) It is understood that should you fail to meet your payment obligations, SBCS reserves the right to deny you access to face to face or on-line classes; to restrict your access to on-line resources and to withhold certificates and awards until payment is made in full.
