ACCA Applied Knowledge/ ACCA Diploma in Accounting and Business (RQF Level 4) BT/FBT - Business and Technology	You'll develop knowledge and understanding of the business and its environment and the influence this has on how organisations are structured and on the role of accounting and other key business functions in contributing to the efficient, effective and ethical management and development of an organization, its people and systems. You will learn the purpose and types of businesses, and their interactions with stakeholders and the external environment; the business organisation structure, functions and the role of corporate governance; the function of	

ACCA Applied Knowledge/ ACCA Diploma in Accounting and Business	accountancy and audit; the principles of authority, leadership and team management; why personal effectiveness is the basis for effective team and organisational behavior; why upholding professional ethics and professional values in business is important. You'll develop knowledge and understanding of management accounting techniques to support management in planning, controlling and monitoring performance in a variety of business contexts.
(RQF Level 4) O MA/FMA - Management Accounting	You will learn the nature, source and purpose of management information; cost accounting techniques; budgets for planning and control comparisons and analysis of variances; performance measurement and monitoring of business performance.
ACCA Applied Knowledge/ ACCA Diploma in Accounting and Business (RQF Level 4) • FA/FFA - Financial Accounting	You'll develop knowledge and understanding of the underlying principles and concepts relating to financial accounting and technical proficiency in the use of double-entry accounting techniques, including the preparation of basic financial statements for single entities and simple groups. You'll also be introduced to basic techniques of interpretation of financial statements. You will learn to demonstrate technical proficiency in the use of double-entry and accounting systems; how to record, process and report business transactions; to understand the context and purpose of financial reporting apply the qualitative characteristics of financial information; how to prepare a trial balance (including identifying and correcting errors); how to prepare basic financial statements for incorporated and unincorporated entities
Career Builder: Essential Skills for Academic and Professional Success	The Fulltime Career Builder Course is designed to equip tertiary-level students with essential life and career skills that bridge the gap between secondary education and the Professional world. Over 25 guided learning hours, students will gain foundational knowledge in financial literacy, communication, digital safety, emotional intelligence, and professional development. Through interactive sessions, the programme fosters both personal growth and career readiness, supporting a smooth transition into higher education and the workforce.
Project Management	The programme is designed to introduce students to project management concepts. Participants will be introduced to the key concepts, principles and methods for managing projects effectively. The project life cycle and

Short Caboola	project management processes will be discussed, and practical opportunities will be provided for project management techniques to be applied to relevant activities. A mix of case studies, videos, and questionnaires will be utilised. At the end of this introductory course, participants will have the knowledge and skills required to manage a small project within an organisational context.
Study Schools	Intense question-based revision sessions to be held in November 2025 in preparation for BT/FBT, MA/FMA, and FA/FFA exams in December 2025.
